Pray the Prayer of Healing - Our leaders are constantly under spiritual attack by the enemy. Pray for the continuous healing of your leaders that God will keep their bodies healed and that they will prosper, stay in good health even as their souls prosper. (3 John 2)

Pray the Prayer of Wisdom & Revelation - Pray that the Spirit of the Lord will rest upon our leaders through the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, and the spirit of knowledge as they engage in business transactions on behalf of the kingdom of God. (Isa. 11:2; Col. 1:9-13)

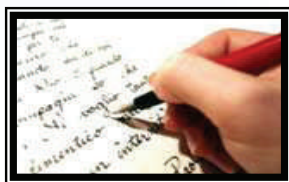
